THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

A course of 6 obstacles (one double) is build at 1m45. Every time a rider enters the ring, he must raise one fence of his choice, from the first jump off. The first fault will eliminate the rider. In this case the fence that was raised will be put back to its original height. The fences can only be raised a second time if all the fences were raised and stayed at this height. In case of equality of penalties after the 3rd jump off, a 4th jump off on time, without changing the height of the fences, will take place as final tiebreaker. Max. height & spread in the fourth round are: Height: 1m70 max. – Spread: 2m max. – Triple bar : 2m20 max.
